**Program Completion Rate**

Program Completion is defined as the number of students who complete the program within the stated program length. Our program specifies the entry point as the final drop/add date to calculate the program’s completion rate. When calculating the total number of students enrolled in the program (denominator), programs need not consider students who attrite due to nonacademic reasons such as: financial, medical/mental health, or family reasons; military deployment; a change in major/course of study; and/or other reasons an institution may classify as a nonacademic withdrawal.
